Please ensure you send a water bottle in on Wednesdays as children will be going to off-site gymnastics.

A few reminders ...

- Please could reading bags be in school every day. Children will continue to have Reading Practice
 sessions in school and will change their reading for pleasure books as they need to. It is very
 helpful if your child can read with an adult at home every night for at least 10 minutes.
- If your child is absent for any reason please phone school to let us know the reason.
- Homework will be set on Fridays and due back in on Wednesdays.
- Please encourage your child to learn spellings (set on Friday, tested on the following Friday). The
 focus will be on spellings taught in phonics that week. If you have any queries please see your
 child's class teacher. After a brief break in December, these are back again every week!
- Medicine if you need the class teacher to administer medicine to your child you need to complete forms from the office which need to be signed by yourself and the class teacher.
- Please ensure all of your child's belongings are clearly labelled with their name. Thank you for your continued support.
