# SPRING TERM 2024

Welcome back to all of our Nursery families. The children have settled back into Nursery life brilliantly and we look forward to a busy, fun and engaging term together.

## **Our Topics**

Our learning in the first half of this term will be linked to winter and Animals in Cold Lands. We will investigate the winter weather and learn how different animals keep warm in the winter months. We will also find out about animals that live in the colder regions of the world. We will read and retell the story of 'One Snowy Night' and will even meet the character of Percy the Park Keeper! Percy will encourage us to make feeders for the birds to help keep them fed over the winter months. Other stories of the week include 'Cuddly Duddly' and non-fiction books about Polar animals. Just before half term break, we will learn about Chinese New Year and will enjoy a Chinese New Year celebration day!

In the second half of this term, we will be finding out about our bodies and how to keep them healthy. We will celebrate all of the amazing things we can do and will practise being resilient when learning new skills. Just before the Easter break, we will enjoy a spring walk where we will take cameras and clipboards to help record all of the seasonal changes we notice.

After the holidays, our home corner will transform into our very own café. As part of this project, we will visit a real café in the local community! Further information will be sent in a separate letter.

### Festivals, Seasons and Traditions

This year, Chinese New Year is on 10<sup>th</sup> February. In Nursery, we will learn about this festival by singing songs, creating art work and reading stories. This will provide us with the opportunity to explore the customs and traditions of Chinese culture. We will also celebrate the spring festivals, Mother's Day and Easter.

Every Monday we will continue to introduce a new letter and its sound to the children. It would be lovely if the children could bring in an object from home to add to our display each week. We will continue to update you each week via our class Dojo page.

Every week, we will learn rhymes based around our topics and themes. Keep a look out on the notice boards and Class Dojo for our rhyme of the week.
