Numeracy and Literacy lessons will be more theme based and our topics will include leisure & entertainment in the 20th Century and Climate Change in geography, renewable energy in science and brave colour in art. The children will be using the computer programme 'Tinkercad' to design and create 3D desk organisers that will be printed using a 3D printer. We are also looking forward to an exciting arts week.
