Happy New Year! We hope you had a lovely Christmas break and are ready to get stuck into our second term in F1. We are so proud of how well our children have settled back into Haydn Nursery life and we look forward to a busy, fun and engaging term together.

Our Topics

Our learning in the first half of this term will be linked to winter and animals that live in cold lands. We will investigate the winter weather and learn how different animals keep warm. We will read and retell the story of 'One Snowy Night' and will even meet the main character - Percy the Park Keeper! Percy will encourage us to make feeders for the birds to help keep them fed over the winter months. Other stories of the week include 'Cuddly Dudley' and non-fiction books about Polar animals. Just before half term break, we will celebrate Chinese New Year.

Our second part of spring term is titled, 'Time for Tea!' We will learn all about our bodies and how to keep them healthy. We will enjoy reading 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' as our special story and our home corner will be transformed into our very own café. As part of this project, we will visit a real café in the local community! Further information will be sent in a separate letter.

Festivals, Seasons and Traditions

Chinese New Year falls on Wednesday 29th January this year. In nursery, we will be celebrating the festival on the week commencing 10th February. The children will have the chance to taste Chinese food, create artwork, sing songs and join in with a dragon parade all the way around school! We will also be celebrating the spring festivals of Mother's Day, (look out for an invitation to our Mother's Day Café) and Easter, where we will take part in an Easter egg hunt and Easter bonnet parade.

Letter Sound of the Week

Every Monday, we will continue to introduce a new letter sound to the children. It would be lovely if the children could bring in an object from home to add to our display each week. We will continue to update you each week via our class Dojo page. Please remember, we do not allow the children to bring other toys to nursery.

Rhyme of the week


